PRESERVE IS OPEN SUNRISE TO SUNSET ONLY

LEASH YOUR DOG
 Keeping your dog in control keeps people, other dogs, and wildlife safe. Dogs must be leashed at all times on the preserve.



PICK UP POOP
 Dog waste is a health hazard. It also increases the nitrogen in the soil, making it hard for native plants to survive, and contributes to water pollution. Please bag your pet's waste and take it with you.

TRASH YOUR TRASH
 Please pick up all trash — yours and others'. Even biodegradable materials like apple cores and orange peels take years to break down and attract scavengers that can harm native wildlife. What's more, trash is unsightly and takes away from the preserve's natural beauty.



Stick to Trails
 Staying on trails protects wildlife and their homes. Shortcutting trails causes erosion and damages trailside plants. Please walk on designated trails only.

Hunting and Fishing
 Hunting, fishing and trapping are not permitted. Deer hunting by special permit only. Contact the preserve manager for permit information.

Be a Good Neighbor
 There are a number of private residences within and adjoining the preserve. Please respect our neighbors' privacy.

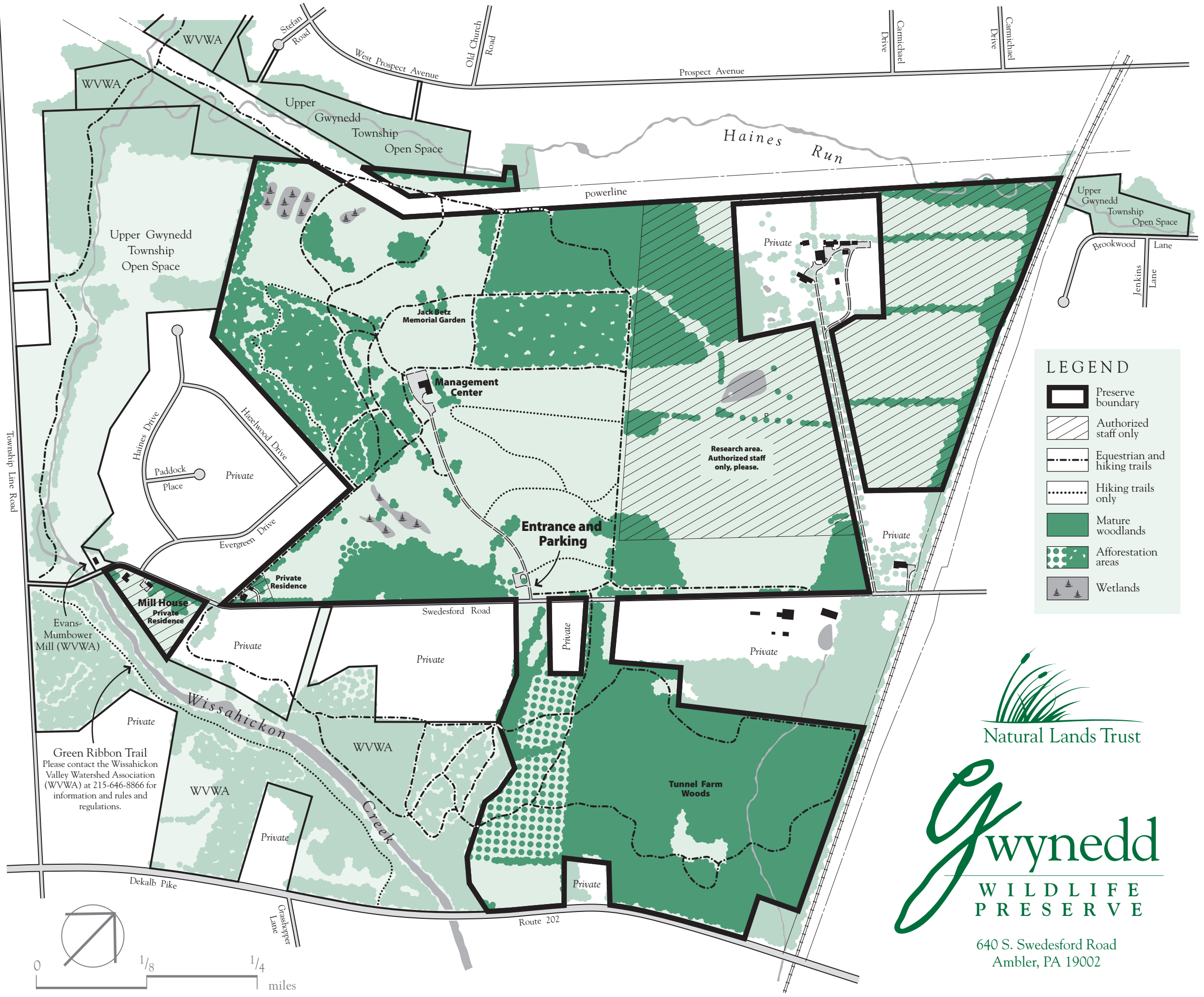
Foot Traffic Only
 No motorized vehicles or mountain bikes, please. Such vehicles can be destructive to plants and wildlife and disrupt the quiet experience others are here to enjoy.

Keep Aquatic Habitats Healthy
 To avoid disturbing aquatic plants and wildlife and prevent erosion, please stay out of wetlands, creeks and ponds. Swimming is prohibited.

Leave It as You Find It
 Please leave all plants, flowers, animals, rocks and artifacts for all visitors to enjoy.

Horseback Riding
 Horseback riding by permit only and only on designated trails under good conditions. Please ride to and from the preserve. We cannot accommodate horse trailers. Contact the preserve manager for more information.
