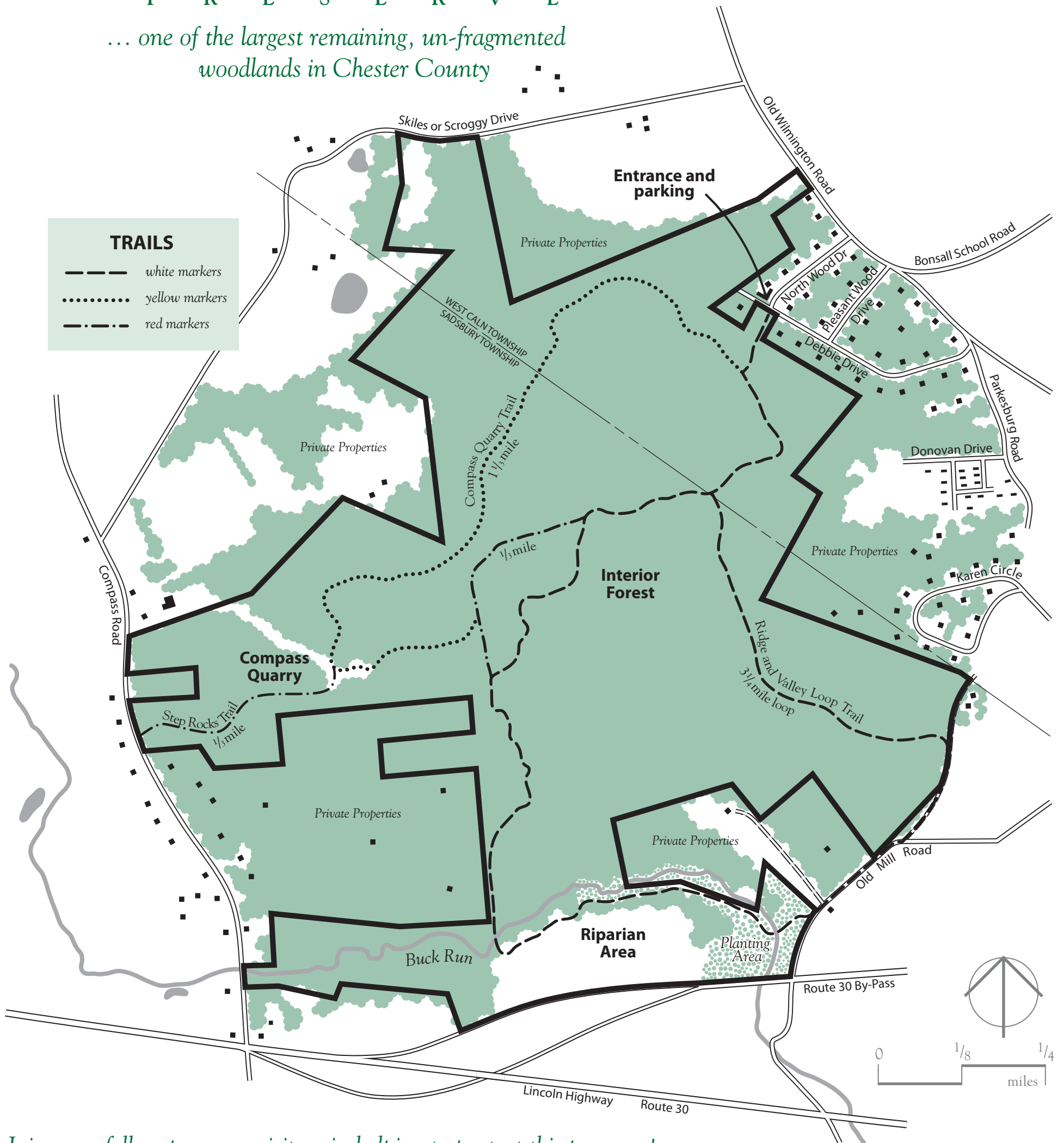


# Sadsbury Woods

## STICK TO TRAILS

Staying on trails protects wildlife and their homes. Shortcutting trails causes erosion and damages trailside plants. Please walk and ride on designated trails only.



## MANAGE YOUR DOG

Keeping your dog in control keeps people, other dogs, and wildlife safe. Dogs must be leashed at all times on the preserve.

## PICK UP POOP

Dog waste is a health hazard. It also increases the nitrogen in the soil, making it hard for native plants to survive, and contributes to water pollution. Always clean up your dog's poop—wherever it's left—and take it with you.



## Leave It As You Find It

Please leave all plants, flowers, animals, rocks, and artifacts for all visitors to enjoy.

## Hunting and Fishing

Hunting, fishing and trapping are not permitted. (Deer hunting by special permit only. Contact the preserve manager for information.)

## Horseback Riding

Horseback riding is permitted on designated trails under good conditions. Please ride to and from the preserve. We cannot accommodate horse trailers.
